

## Tuition and Fees

### Master of Science in Physician Assistant Studies, 2025-2026

The Master of Science in Physician Assistant Studies program cost of attendance represents both direct expenses of tuition and fees as well as estimated indirect expenses you may incur for the six trimester program. Direct expenses are billed by the school each trimester, while financial aid (including all federal loans) generally is awarded over a two-trimester period (e.g. as defining an academic year).
